<ul> <li>If you are under 18 years of age:</li> <li>Class D: The application must be signed by a parent, legal guardian, social worker, or boarding school headmaster. If the person signing the application IS NOT a parent, documentation of the person's guard status must be shown at the time of the road test to prove that the person is qualified to sign.</li> <li>Class M: You must successfully complete a Massachusetts Rider Education Program (MREP) basic ride course to obtain a Class M license</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>□ A valid learner's permit. The official paper permit must be legible; or a duplicate permit will be required.</li> <li>□ A sponsor (Class D only; Class M road tests do not require a sponsor)</li> <li>• Your sponsor must: (a) be 21 years of age or older; (b) have at least one year of driving experience; and (c) duly licensed by his/her state of residence</li> </ul>	be

Vehicles used for Road Tests:	
Effective May 2, 2022, all applicants must provide their own vehicle or motorcycle for testing. Passenger vehicles, motorcycles, vehicles with an ignition interlock device, and vehicles with adaptive equipment for a competency test meet the following requirements:	nust
Applicants must clean/wipe-down surfaces on the passenger side and center of the vehicle prior to the test and windows to maintain ventilation during the test.	open
<ul><li>□ Be in good working condition and be able to pass a safety check.</li><li>□ Have a valid registration and current inspection sticker.</li></ul>	
<ul> <li>Contain adequate seating accommodations next to the operator for the use of the examiner.</li> <li>Be designed to let the examiner make an emergency stop using the parking brake. If not, the vehicle CANNOT bused.</li> </ul>	ре
<ul> <li>Any vehicle with a center console that does not have a parking brake as part of the console CANNOT be used.</li> <li>Any vehicle that does not allow the examiner unobstructed access to the parking brake CANNOT be used.</li> </ul>	ed.
The examiner's goal is to observe your driving performance. During a Class D road test, ye should be prepared to demonstrate your ability to:	ou
☐ Use hand signals	
<ul><li>☐ Start the engine</li><li>☐ Start and stop the vehicle</li></ul>	
☐ Parallel Park	
☐ Back the vehicle approximately 50 feet	
<ul><li>☐ Make left - right turns</li><li>☐ Start, stop, and turn the vehicle on a hill</li></ul>	
☐ Turn around between curbs (three-point turn)	
☐ Enter and leave intersections	
<ul><li>☐ Recognize and obey traffic signs, lights and signals, and other rules of the road</li><li>☐ Use good driving sense</li></ul>	
☐ Use good driving posture, with both hands always placed properly on the wheel	
<ul><li>□ Drive in the proper lane and look carefully and signal properly before changing lanes</li><li>□ Maintain enough distance between your vehicle and the one ahead of you</li></ul>	
☐ Always drive at safe speeds to comply with speed limits and varying traffic conditions	
☐ Properly yield the right-of-way
